



University of the Arts London Canadian Financial Guide for 2016/17

The Federal and Provincial Governments offer loans to Canadians studying at the University of the Arts London.

We are a public institution and our Canadian school code is PXAD.

Students interested in applying for a loan must do so through their provincial/territorial student assistance office (details for each province are listed at the end of this document).

When you apply for a loan, you are considered for funding by both the Provincial and Federal Governments, meaning you only have to apply once for funding for the year. While federal loans are handled through the National Student Loans Service Centre, provincial loans are handled through the provincial governments and student aid branches.

If your course is longer than a year, you should be eligible to apply for a new set of loans each year.

Please refer to [Campus Access](#) for a comprehensive overview on the loan/grant application process. Please also note that Canadian loans are means-tested, meaning you must demonstrate financial need in order to qualify for funding.

The Canadian Government, not the University, will process most of your loans so you will have to direct your queries to them.

You will be given several forms before and during your course that must be completed by the University since they confirm enrolment, student status and fees associated with your studies. These documents must be brought to the Student Funding Service, not your local college office:

Canadian Taxpayers

Canadian taxpayers, who are studying full-time on a degree at University of the Arts London are eligible to claim the appropriate percentage of tuition fees paid (subject to certain restrictions) as a tax credit.

Also the parent or guardian is eligible to claim the transferred portion of tuition fees allowed under the Canadian Income Tax Act.

Students wishing to make such a claim need to ensure that they have receipts bearing the name of the University, not just the College.

In order to make a claim you have to submit a **TL11A form** so please request one to be completed by the Student Funding Service at the end of each tax year.
