



## University of the Arts London Canadian Financial Guide

The Federal and Provincial Governments offer loans to Canadians studying at the University of the Arts London.

### School code

UAL is a public institution and our Canadian school code is **PXAD**.

### How and where to apply for the loans

- Students interested in applying for a loan must do so through their provincial/territorial student assistance office (details for each province are listed at the end of this document).
- A comprehensive overview on the loan/grant application process can be found on [Campus Access](#) website.
- When you apply for a loan, you are considered for funding by both the Provincial Government, handled through the provincial governments and student aid branches and Federal Government, handled by the National Student Loans Service Centre.
- You need to re-apply for your funding every year.
- Canadian loans are means-tested, meaning you must demonstrate financial need in order to qualify for funding.
- The Canadian Government, not the University, will process most of your loans so you will have to direct your queries to them.

### Course eligibility

Please note that not all courses offered at the UAL will be eligible for funding from your province or territory. You will have to check with the student assistance office nearest you.

## Canadian Taxpayers

Canadian taxpayers, who are studying full-time on a degree at UAL are eligible to claim the appropriate percentage of tuition fees paid (subject to certain restrictions) as a tax credit.

Also the parent or guardian is eligible to claim the transferred portion of tuition fees allowed under the Canadian Income Tax Act.

Students wishing to make such a claim need to ensure that they have receipts bearing the name of the University of the Arts London, not just the College.

In order to make a claim you have to submit a **TL11A** form so please request one to be completed by the Student Funding Service at the end of each tax year.
