Resources become locked up, capacity is built, things become more efficient, more fixed. Late phase resources devoted to maintenance, increasing vulnerability

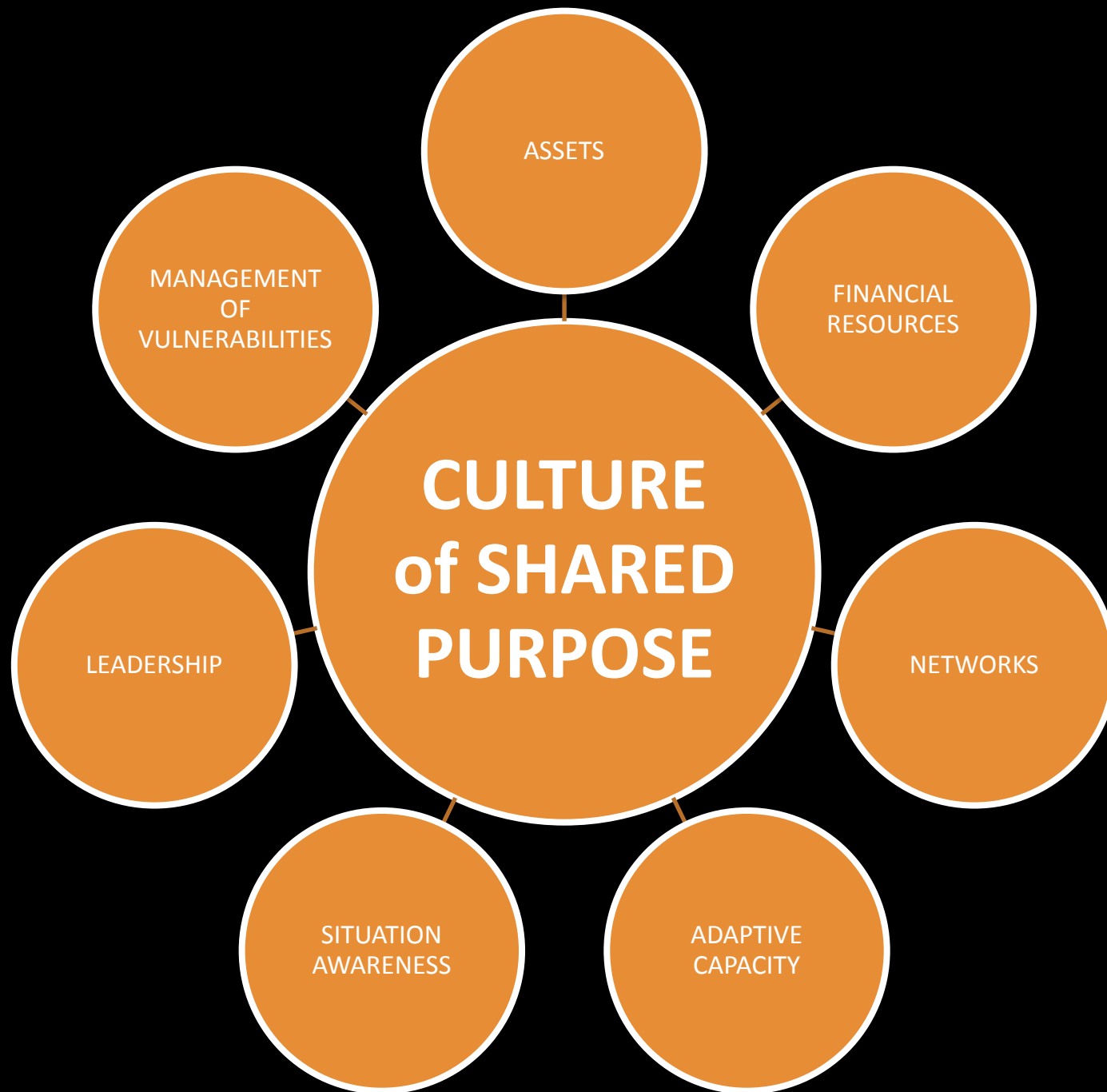
THE ADAPTIVE CYCLE
