

Connect to UAL-WiFi (Windows)

This guide should connect most Windows computers to WiFi.

The wireless card must be set to **On** and DHCP set to **Auto** (this should be set automatically on most computers).

You may need administrative privileges on the system to perform certain operations.

01. Go to the **system tray** in the bottom right corner of your screen.
02. Click the **Network/Wireless icon** to view the available wireless connections b.
03. Choose **UAL-WiFi**
04. Click **Connect**.
05. Enter your **UAL username** and **password**
06. Click **Ok**.
07. You're now connected to WiFi.

Connecting to UAL WiFi after resetting your password
