

Process for awarding results in Summer 2020

Producing results

Step 1

Centres submit Centre Assessment Grades based on evidence produced prior to 20 March 2020

Step 2

UAL Awarding Body External Quality Assurers sample grades and evidence to ensure consistency, validity, reliability and fairness

Step 3

All grades are reviewed against national benchmarks and approved by UAL Awarding Body Board of Examiners

Results issued to students by centres

13 August 2020

Level 3 and 4 qualification results released by colleges and schools
Confirmation decisions from Universities will start to become visible as released by UCAS

20 August 2020

Level 1 and 2 qualification results released by colleges and schools

Appeals

The only exception to this is an appeal on the basis of bias and discrimination. Appeals applications must be submitted by the following dates:

26 August 2020

2 September 2020

Appeals application deadline for Level 1 and 2 qualifications
