

'Back to Nurture' - an illustrated talk about intimacy and one-to-one performance by Adrian Howells

In this talk, Glasgow-based performance-maker Adrian Howells will focus on the intimate and tactile work he has been creating within the one-to-one performance context, often autobiographical and confessional in nature - and frequently in site-responsive locations - over the past 10 years. He will pay particular attention to talking about his performances 'Foot Washing for the Sole', 'The Garden of Adrian' and 'The Pleasure of Being: Washing, Feeding, Holding', as well as his recent touch-based and non-verbal communication work collaborating with individuals with complex sensory and cognitive impairment.

Adrian's work has frequently been supported by the British Council to present work at international theatre and performance festivals throughout the world, including in Japan, Singapore, Israel, Canada, Germany, Spain, Italy and Ireland, as well as at many festivals throughout Britain.
