### Guidelines for Post-Grad Community Stories

[Post-Grad Community](#) is your platform to connect, create and collaborate with UAL's creative postgraduate network.

[Post-Grad Stories](#) is a space for amplifying the postgraduate student voice at UAL and for sharing practices and experiences with UAL's ever-growing audience. It's a place for you to have your say through written articles, present your work through imagery, and report on your interests and experiences during your time at UAL and beyond.

### Writing Guidance

Post-Grad Community accepts all kinds of Stories to publish. These can include:

- Reviews (books, exhibitions)
- Reports on artist residencies
- Opinion pieces
- Photo essays
- Interviews
- Updates on your current work or final projects

Let the audience know what they are about to read, and highlight why the postgraduate student community might want to hear about this.

Provide engaging images to illustrate your story (we recommend 1 image per 100 words). Ensure these images are as hi-res as possible, and provide captions for each image.

Add any links for further information on your story, let people know how they can find out more and engage with the content. Be sure to include any links to your portfolios, website, or social media.

### Word Count

There is no word count for a story, we recommend at least 500 - 700 words per article, depending on the context.

## **Submission**

Send the text in a word document, with images placed in order throughout the text. Be sure to also separately send original .jpgs of the images for us to be able to upload them.
