Guidelines for student articles

What is this article? A book/exhibition review? A report on a residency? An opinion piece? Inform the audience about what they are about to read.

Check out previous examples on the Post-Grad Stories page:

Highlight why the postgraduate student community might want to hear about this.

Present the context for what you are writing about.

Provide engaging images to illustrate your story (maximum of 6 landscape hi res images) think about which one would be best for the page banner – see previous articles for ideas.

Add any links for further information on your story, let people know how they can find out more and engage

There is no word count for a story but think about how long your reader may have to allocate to the piece. Keep it short and get to the point – average story is 700 words.

Send the text as a word document and images separately – preferred numbered in order of where they should sit within the text with these image numbers also in the word document.

Feel free to send us a draft of your story in progress and we can discuss changes and improvements.
